Notes:

1. People in Emergency Shelter increased 13% due to the addition of two new safe stay shelter communities in 2024.
2. People in TH increased 7% from 2023.
3. Number of sheltered seniors aged 62 or older increased 29% as a result of prioritizing that population for the new Bertha's Place shelters. Unsheltered seniors decreased by 33% in 2024.
4. Unsheltered people decreased .4% from the 2023 count. Chronically homeless sheltered individuals increased 47% from 2023 while chronically homeless unsheltered individuals decreased -31%. Unsheltered veterans decreased 42% with 31 in 2023 and 18 in 2024.
5. Unsheltered families increased 44% with 43 in 2023 and 62 in 2024.
